AT THE HEART OF IT



hat is your favorite part about the Iowa State Fair – the food, the animals, the rides, the concerts? As one of the most common questions I receive, my honest answer is, "every bit of it." Because that is typically not a satisfactory response, I will narrow it down. The answer? It's resounding and clear: "the people." The people are at the heart of it all.

The Iowa State Fair would not be one of the most prestigious and well-loved events in the country without the people who attend, enjoy, compete, support, serve, and bring it all to life. And this August, there were quite a few people at that. Attendance totaled 1,133,958, the second highest in the Fair's 169-year history. Sunday, August 13 saw 114,937 Fairgoers, a first Sunday record. The Grandstand entertained 112,258 concertgoers, including 9,294 who worshipped with For King + Country on Opening Day – the Fair's largest contemporary Christian concert ever. Other records include 107 Fairtime sponsors who contributed more than \$2.83 million, 668 Blue Ribbon Foundation volunteers who served 5,150 hours, and thousands of donors who helped surpass the Foundation's 30-year total of \$200 million raised for capital improvements – the list could go on. Suffice it to say, we are grateful to the dedicated patrons who made the 2023 Fair such a success.

Numbers aside, the true joy of the Fair resides in everyone coming together to celebrate all that is good about Iowa. No matter their background, people from all over the state, country, and world can unite and enjoy a slice of heaven – of Iowa – at the Fair. It's where tradition meets innovation, rural meets urban, and past generations meet future generations. It's one big family reunion. Bringing people together, physically and figuratively, is at the heart of the Iowa State Fair, whether it's through a shared love of corndogs, equal amazement at the hatching baby chicks, or synchronized "cheers" at the Iowa Craft Beer Tent. During these 11 days, the best of our state's people, character, and culture certainly comes to light.

Though the Fair is just 11 days long, it takes countless more days (and people) to create such a meaningful event. In my role as Sponsorship Director, I get to partner with the 100+ Fairtime sponsors who showcase their leading work in agriculture, industry, technology, and entertainment. It's wonderful to see everyone's hard work come to fruition in August, as well as their commitment to the prosperity of both our Fair and the communities we serve. To serve them in return, bring people joy, and work together to provide the best possible experience for Fairgoers is a real blessing.

So now I must ask you: what is your favorite part about the Iowa State Fair? Maybe it's testing your vocal cords in the husband calling contest or cheering on one of the 104 county queens competing for the Fair Queen title. Maybe it's feeling like a kid again while "riding" a John Deere tractor or watching grandchildren exhibit prize livestock as you once did. Each individual has a unique, personal connection to the Fair, so whatever your answer is to that quite difficult question, one thing remains at the heart of it all: the people. And truly, nothing compares to the people of the Iowa State Fair.

2023 CORNDOG KICKOFF BENEFIT AUCTION AND FAIR FOOD GRAZING PARTY



The Iowa State Fair Blue Ribbon Foundation's 2023 **Corndog Kickoff Benefit Auction and Fair Food Grazing Party** on Saturday, July 8 was a true celebration of lowans' favorite days in August. The event raised a record total \$1,006,590 for the renovation and preservation of the historic Iowa State Fairgrounds!

More than 2,500 lowa State Fair supporters gathered for a night of fun, food and fundraising. The Blue Ribbon Foundation auctioned off 34 live and 273 silent auction packages. Attendees won prizes on the spin wheel and took their photo with a special backdrop. Some guests also chose to participate in the Rags to Riches, Mystery Prize and Dining Delights games.

"The Corndog Kickoff set a tremendous record this year in terms of attendance and dollars raised," said Peter Cownie, Blue Ribbon Foundation Executive Director. "The Blue Ribbon Foundation is grateful for the Fairlovers who came out to support the grand tradition that we all hold near and dear to our hearts. Thank you on behalf of the Blue Ribbon Foundation and the Iowa State Fair for a remarkable evening."





IOWA STATE FAIR Highlights

- The Blue Ribbon Foundation hopes you noticed several new improvements to the Fairgrounds. The Public Safety building expanded with a 2-story addition and renovation of the existing space will start this fall. The Fairview Tap's fresh landscape and extended seating was enjoyed by Fairgoers, and the Elwell Family Park's permanent restrooms were a much-needed enhancement to the event space.
- The Blue Ribbon Foundation sold \$503,000 worth of merchandise during the Iowa State Fair. Top selling items were t-shirts, sweatshirts, hats, charms and the Butter Cow stuffed animal. In addition, more than 105,000 bottles of water were sold! Both of these fundraisers wouldn't be possible without the help of our outstanding volunteers.
- In 2022, the Iowa State Fair Blue Ribbon Foundation received a generous \$1 million contribution from Alliant Energy to build a new shelter house called the Alliant Energy Landing, which hosted different events throughout the year. For 2023, Alliant Energy sponsored a mural painted on the Landing's retaining wall that was created by local artist, James Navarro. Focusing on agriculture education, several panels line the wall with different Iowa-themed vignettes. Thank you so much to James Navarro for bringing his creativity to the Fairgrounds and to Alliant Energy for supporting the improvements.
- Thank you to the Iowa Auctioneers Association for graciously donating the profits from their auctioneer showcase during the Fair. Auctioneers from across the Midwest showed off their selling skills resulting in a \$3,000 donation to the Blue Ribbon Foundation.
- Tracy Forbes volunteers in the Blue Ribbon Foundation office every day during the Iowa State Fair (and weekly throughout the year). She always goes the extra step to help everyone she can. From answering questions to helping with whatever our staff needs, Tracy deserves all of the praise! She was one of the 2023 Iowa State Fair Everyday Impact Award winners.
- Thank you to the late Tim Mallicoat Concrete Supply Inc., Sonny Hall – Absolute Group, and the Iowa Concrete Paving Association for their generosity in donating and facilitating the paved surface at the Iowa Craft Beer Tent. Fairgoers appreciated the update, especially after the rainy day.
- The Blue Ribbon Foundation held the annual all-day BINGO fundraiser on the Grand Concourse. A total of 3,838 people played in 84 games of BINGO, helping the Blue Ribbon Foundation raise \$3,497.
- The Woodcarvers' Auction raised \$66,609. All proceeds from the auction are dedicated to Our Fair's Future, the Blue Ribbon Foundation's endowment fund. A special thank you to Chainsaw Artists - Gary Keenan, T.J. Jenkins and Clint Henik for producing such outstanding pieces of art.





any people run on coffee, but like most non-profit organizations, the Blue Ribbon Foundation runs on volunteers. Volunteering is an integral part of Iowans' lives. The Blue Ribbon Foundation proudly honors outstanding state-wide volunteers with the "Iowan of the Day" award during the Iowa State Fair.

The winners were celebrated during a presentation on the Anne & Bill Riley Stage and received \$200 cash, use of a golf cart for the day, VIP parking, gate admission for four, hotel accommodations at the Des Moines Downtown Marriott, and four tickets to the evening Grandstand show.


successful Corndog Kickoff or Fair without their help.
























BACK THE BARNS PROJECT / nota



In early 2023, the Iowa State Fair broke ground on the first phase of an exciting \$25 million livestock barns renovation project.

Specifically in the Sheep Barn, we hope you enjoyed the new air conditioned restrooms, family rooms and office. Underground sanitary water upgrades were also completed. The second phase, starting this fall, includes restoration of the beautiful terra cotta architectural accents, brick work, improvements to the east restrooms and roof replacement.

All four livestock buildings will receive attention with projects specifically tailored to each barn over the next few years. Renovations of the historic, early 20th century animal barns will give generations of Fairgoers the opportunity to continue the timenonored tradition of showing their livestock at the Iowa State Fair.



Art Kaae will be 80 years old in January. Even with his self-described weak knees, you couldn't keep Art away from the lowa State Fair. He attended four days this year — spending time around the livestock barns, admiring the tractors and of course, enjoying the food.

Art grew up on a farm outside of Cedar Falls and has lived in lowa his entire life. He stays busy on his acreage north of Cedar Falls with Elle, his Border Collie, while raising goats and bottle calves.

"Spending time with the animals keeps me active," said Art, "so it's not a surprise that I spend a lot of my time at the Iowa State Fair in the livestock barns."

Walking around the antique and restored tractors really brings back memories for Art. "I enjoy reliving those memories as a farm kid," said Art. "I loved watching the tractor shows and demonstrations. Those were some of my favorite things to do at the Fair. These current displays remind me of how the lowa State Fair was years ago and the importance of our agriculture roots."

Art has had the opportunity to visit other state and county fairs, but the lowa State Fair is always his favorite. "There are so many different food options," said Art, "but I find myself eating at the Cattlemen's. When you sit down and start talking with other Fairgoers, it feels like a big family."

Art has been a member of the 1854 Society since 2006, but he made his first donation back in 1993. If you ask him why he continually donates to the Blue Ribbon Foundation, his answer is simple. He has a passion for agriculture and wants the youth that work hard raising their animals to have high quality facilities for their exhibits each year.
